

Membership Terms and Conditions

1. Membership is open to anyone.
2. A family is defined as 'a family unit of up to 5 members living in the same household'.
3. By making this application for membership, you understand you are applying for membership of Diversity ACT Community Services Inc (Diversity ACT). You agree with and support Diversity ACT's mission statement of support, understanding, tolerance, respect and acceptance of all LGBTBI members of the community.
4. Members are representatives of Diversity ACT who value and support its name in the wider community.
5. The Committee may at its discretion reject an application or terminate the membership of any person.
6. All membership is to be in accordance the Diversity ACT Association Rules, Diversity ACT Privacy Policy and any laws that govern the membership of an incorporated association in the Australian Capital Territory.
7. Membership does not become valid until it is approved by and announced at a committee meeting and fees are paid in full.
8. Membership is not refundable. Diversity ACT will make refunds of membership fees only where there has been an error in the amount paid for membership. The total amount of any refund will only be the amount required to reimburse an overpayment.
9. Memberships are non-transferable
10. Members are entitled to:
 - a) Access and use facilities and services offered by Diversity ACT (some services have a cost)
 - b) Attend Annual General Meeting (AGM) and vote to elect committee members
 - c) Join work groups to assist in delivering Diversity ACT's services to the community
 - d) Receive monthly newsletters
 - e) Receive benefits of Diversity ACT's Loyalty program.
 - f) Access the living skills system.
11. Diversity ACT will work in accordance with the National Privacy Principles under the Privacy Act 1998 (Cth) and the Diversity ACT Privacy Policy.
12. Diversity ACT may use your details to communicate to its members information on current services, events and meetings.
